Conclusion

- Best practice risk management calls for **integrated** stress tests, as capturing **risk interaction** applies to risk measures and the **overlap** in **customer/strategic** behavior
- Effective stress testing is facilitated by modeling in a **holistic and unified view**
 - Ensures a consistent risk culture/language throughout the institution
 - Testing becomes more meaningful/actionable to management and regulators
 - Allows for more sophisticated extensions to improve decision making
- When properly architected, a stress testing process can lead to more **informed decisions**, **improved response** times and assist the organization in setting its **strategic vision**
